

Ms. Tanner:

Glenn Puit with the Michigan Land Use Institute. Here are my questions:

1. What was Allan Bruder's role in the decision by Wolverine to locate the Clean Energy Venture in Presque Isle County?

2. What was the date of his earliest involvement in the project and discussions with economic development and Wolverine leaders?

Wolverine's 990 forms with the IRS show Allan Bruder accepted the following compensation from his position on Wolverine's Board of Directors:

2006 -- \$24,200 plus a \$5,534 expense account.

2005 -- \$21,450 plus a \$5,062 expense account.

2004 -- \$15,900 plus expense account of \$1,644.

3. When was Mr. Bruder first appointed to the Wolverine Board of Directors and when was he first compensated for this position. Also, do you have information on what Mr. Bruder's compensation was from Wolverine in 2007 and 2008?

4. Wolverine's financial report filed with FERC has Mr. Bruder listed as someone who receives compensation of \$50,000 or more. Subsequent to this, in the report, it says none of Wolverine's Board of Directors are paid more than \$50,000. I'm assuming that the latter, then, is correct and applies to Mr. Bruder. Can you confirm that he did not receive more than \$50,000 for the year 2006?

5. Has Allan Bruder received any other compensation or expense reimbursement from Wolverine that would not be listed in Wolverine's 990 reports? If so, how much, and what for?

6. Has Mr. Bruder ever represented Wolverine in the capacity of a lobbyist or advocate? If so, what was his compensation for these roles, if any?

7. Every government expert that I've talked to said that Mr. Bruder's public advocacy for this plant, and his voting on a resolution in support of the Clean Energy Venture, is a significant conflict of interest. Does Wolverine believe it was appropriate to compensate Mr. Bruder at all while

Wolverine's permit application for a coal plant was pending?

8. Has Wolverine ever told Mr. Bruder not to talk to the media about his compensation or involvement with the cooperative?

9. Has Wolverine paid any other monies to any other member to the Presque Isle Board of Commissioners, the Presque Isle Planning Commission, or any other government official in Presque Isle County or Rogers City. My question encompasses any monies for expenses, per diems, salary, or any other form of payments.
